FAQ

Q: What is the difference between U800/Unrated Section and Non-rated Section?

A: The 800/Unrated section are for players who wish to receive a USCF rating, or already have a rating. They must be current or new USCF members. To register for USCF membership, visit the [USCF Membership Store](#).

The Non-rated section is for players who want to experience tournament play and compete for trophies and medals, but who do not wish to obtain a USCF rating. They are not USCF members.

Q: What should we do when we arrive at Elm City?

A: Be sure to check in with the registrar at the front table. Then all parents and players should wait in the gym until Round 1 begins. Parents should bring reading material. Internet log-in is not provided. Bringing comfortable seat cushions is a good idea.

Q: What time will tournament end?

A: It depends on the section, the number of players, and the Round times. For Open and U1700 sections, usually play ends around 6pm, with awards to follow. For other sections, play ends around 4:00 or asap, with awards to follow (see below).

Q: Can I leave my child and pick him/her up later?

A: All younger players must be accompanied by an adult or team coach for the entire tournament.

Q: Will there be refreshments/lunch?

A: Morning sale of refreshments include coffee, juices, bottled water, donuts, muffins, bagels. For lunch will be pizza on sale. Please notify the tournament registrar upon check-in how many slices you would like so we order enough pizza.

Q: If we need to leave early, what should we do?

A: Please remember if you need to leave before the last round, please notify the tournament director so that you will not be paired for upcoming rounds. This is a common courtesy for all players that may be paired with you in upcoming rounds, and allow the tournament to run smoothly.

Q: Do USCF Rules apply to all sections, even the Non-rated section?

A: Yes.

Q: Must all players take notation of their games?

A: Yes for all Open and U1700 players. For other sections notation is optional, but if you are not taking notation and you are paired with someone who is taking notation, 5 minutes will be removed from your clock. If both players decide not to take notation, there will be no time penalty.

Q: What equipment (chess sets, clocks, etc.) should we bring?

A: Chess sets, notation sheets and clocks will be provided for tournament play. You may bring your own if you want, or purchase equipment at the tournament.
